Call for Director Nominations

Dear Member,

In accordance with the [Constitution of the Australian Acupuncture and Chinese Medicine Association Ltd](#) (the Constitution) Nominations for Elected Director Positions are now open. The process for each is summarised below for your reference;

Nominations for Elected Director Positions

[Nominations are now open](#) for two *Elected Director* position on the Board of the Australian Acupuncture and Chinese Medicine Association Ltd (the Board). This position is for a three year period and all nominees are required to meet the criteria of being an Elected Director as stipulated in the AACMA Constitution and Australian Law, including being a financial Practising Member and having a valid Director Identification Number.

Members wishing to nominate for an Elected Director position are required by the Board to speak with the AACMA Company Secretary and a current AACMA Board Director to ensure they have a clear understanding of the requirements, responsibilities and restrictions of being a director and that they do not have any issues that would prevent them from qualifying for the position.

Elected Directors are required to sign the [Board Code of Ethics Policy](#) and *abide by the* [AACMA Code of Conduct](#).
